

Hobart International Airport Disabled Permit Holder Car Park Fact Sheet

Hobart International Airport provides a number of parking options for car park users who hold a disabled car parking permit.

The new and improved passenger drop off and pick up lane has significantly improved access for disabled permit holders at Hobart International Airport. Disabled parking bays are now located closer to the terminal and at terminal entry points for ease of entry.

The disabled permit parking bays are attached to purpose built user paths for users with these needs.

The following car park options are available to users with a disabled car parking permit –

Option One - Drop Off and Pick Up Lane

- There are designated disabled parking bays in the drop off and pick up lane at the front of the terminal.
- Users with a disabled permit are able to park in one of the allocated bays and receive thirty minutes of free parking (users without the disabled car parking permit receive two minutes free).
- Due to airport security requirements, the vehicle must remain attended during the thirty minute free parking period.

Option Two – Public Car Park

- There are designated disabled parking bays in the public car park.
- Disabled parking bays in the public car park are located close to the terminal with convenient access for disabled permit holders.
- Standard charges apply to all users of the public car park.

Option Three – Valet Car Park

- All users of the car park can also use the valet car park service for a minimum of two days stay.
- Standard charges apply to all users of the valet car park.
